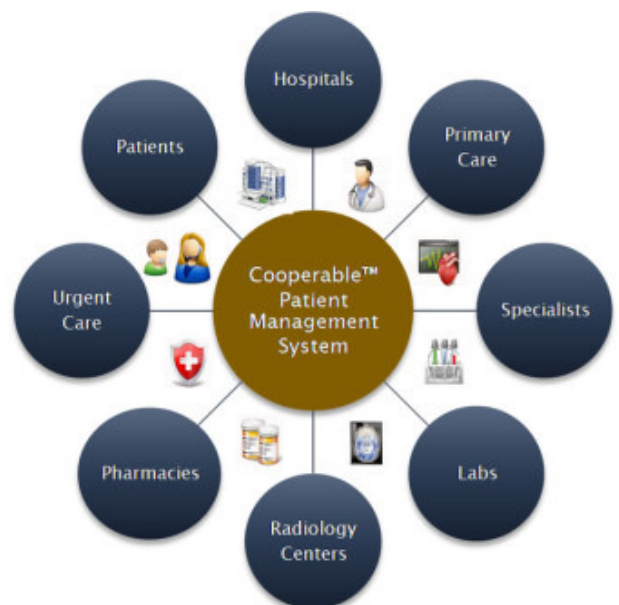

Rapid, Cost Effective Clinical Integration Solution

Antitrust laws, primarily enforced by the Federal Trade Commission (FTC), generally prohibit otherwise competing physicians from jointly negotiating contracts with health plans. However, physician groups can engage in collective bargaining if they are Clinically Integrated. Clinical integration was introduced in 1996 as an alternative to financial integration as a permissible justification for joint negotiations. Approved clinical integration programs usually include the following features:

- Establishment of clinical protocols for the network and their formal adoption
- Commitment by the network's physicians to follow uniform protocols
- An infrastructure system for the reporting of physician compliance with the network's protocols
- Network analysis of both network and individual physician performance
- Network determination of individual physician and network compliance with cost, utilization and quality benchmarks, including identification of physicians out of compliance with the benchmarks
- Significant shared investments in time and money by members – often in the form of investments in shared information technology systems that promote quality improvements and efficiencies. It is often only possible to support such IT investments and the required staff through the collective investments of the network physicians
